### NO SMOKING

The State of Michigan passed legislation (effective May 1, 2010) that prohibits Smoking in all hotels, motels, bars and restaurants and public gathering spaces (DeVos Place). This includes all stair wells and hallways.

The Amway Grand Plaza Hotel has instituted a \$250.00 minimum penalty that will be charged to your room bill for violations; and will report the incident to the local law enforcement.

City of Grand Rapids local ordinance allows smoking outside of buildings, a minimum 10' away from any doors or entrances - both at the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel and the DeVos Place.
